Architectural Review Committee (ARC).

As a reminder, any improvements or changes you plan on making to your property, require a review and signatures obtained through the Architectural Review Committee (ARC). Tree removal requires a separate form be filled out and submitted for review and signatures obtained **before** commencement of work to remove the tree(s).

The Board is working hard to keep abreast of current Sanitary District happenings. The situation is continually changing but just know that your Board is attending meetings and making contacts as needed.

During power outages limit your sewer system usage. Our Sewage System transfers Gilchrist Sewage by electrical pumps to the Crescent Treatment Plant. We have a small amount of sewer storage at each pumping station in Gilchrist. We do not want any overflow issues with our pumping stations.

We encourage you to attend CSD meetings so you can keep abreast yourself and be able to ask questions and offer suggestions as they need them.
